## Attracting and supporting top talent

The School of Social Work offers several giving opportunities to support faculty members and instructional excellence.

Endowed chair and professorship positions bring national recognition to Wayne State, helping to attract and retain leading thinkers in the social work field. Visiting professors help the school enhance its breadth of research and provide collaboration opportunities for faculty and students.

Philanthropic support can also enhance research efforts that lead to the discovery of new knowledge and the advancement of social work practice. Faculty travel and publication support helps this new knowledge reach beyond Detroit to influence change on a broader scale.

Endowed faculty positions and research funds are investments in the future. An endowed fund is permanently available to support Wayne State because your gift is invested as principal and never spent. The faculty position or research fund you establish is then funded through investment earnings. Wayne State's endowment is professionally managed and invested so your gift continues to grow over time.

The amount available to support faculty members each year will depend on the size of the initial gift and the endowment distribution rate. Named chairs and professorships are created once the minimum funding level has been reached, through a single gift or through pledge installments.

Visiting professorship	\$500,000	\$20,000	Provides compensation and research support for a distinguished visiting professor
Faculty development award	\$100,000	\$4,000	Supports research, equipment, travel or other expenses for an outstanding faculty member
Research or travel award	\$25,000	\$1,000	Provides an annual award to support faculty research or travel
